## Weather Advisory January 27, 2012

## High Winds & High Surf Advisory in effect until Saturday afternoon

The National Weather Service has issued an advisory for High Winds & High Surf in the Coastal Orange County area.

The Advisory warns that potentially damaging wind gusts of at least 35 MPH are expected; and 4-6 foot waves and surf with breakers from 7 to 10 feet on exposed west facing beaches - this could create hazardous conditions for boaters entering Dana Point Harbor due to waves washing over the jetties.

Waves & winds this strong can create challenging boating and driving conditions. Please use extra caution.
