High Surf Advisory in Effect

Friday through Monday

The National Weather Service has issued a High Surf advisory for the Coastal Orange County area this weekend.

5 to 10 feet waves with high surf is expected Friday evening, subsiding Monday evening.

High surf is expected to affect Orange County beaches producing rip currents making swimming in the ocean hazardous. People should stay off the jetties as waves can sweep people into the ocean, everyone should use extra caution.
