**PROJECT:** Draft Supplement to Final Environmental Impact Report (Final EIR) No. 564 (SCH No. 96061024) for the James A. Musick Jail Expansion and Operation

**DESCRIPTION:** The proposed project consists of revisions to the **already approved** expansion and operation of the James A. Musick Jail. The previously approved project (approved in 1996) included an increase to a maximum of 7,584 inmates from the current inmate population of approximately 1,250. The population of 7,584 inmates represents a "worst case" scenario. Like the original project, the proposed expansion is anticipated to be phased over time with a variety of inmate population levels occurring over the project buildout, but with a different design and first phase. Related support structures will also be constructed. As with the originally approved project, the project still includes booking and release of inmates, the construction and operation of a warehouse, kitchen, laundry and central plant, and parking structures. Finally, the Southeast Sheriff's station and Interim Care facility will still be located on the site.

This Draft Supplement to Final EIR 564 (certified on 11/5/96) updates selected sections of Final EIR 564. The supplemented topics are: 1) Impacts to Agricultural Lands; and 2) Global Climate Change. The Draft Supplement also includes general additional analyses pursuant to Section 21166 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) regarding other topics that were previously discussed in Final EIR 564. New significant environmental effects were identified in the area of Agricultural Lands, both individually and cumulatively.

**PROJECT LOCATION:** The Musick Jail is located at 13502 Musick Drive in Irvine, CA 92618.

**MEETINGS/HEARINGS:** CEQA does not require formal hearings at any stage of the environmental review process and public comments may be restricted to written communications. Although not required by CEQA, the County of Orange is scheduled to hold a public meeting at the Orange County Planning Commission on Wednesday, **October 24, 2012** at 1:30 p.m. Thereafter, the Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing on a date to be determined. A subsequent notice of the Board of Supervisors hearing will be given that will include the recommendations of the Planning Commission concerning this project. If you challenge the project in court you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at a public meeting or hearing or described in written correspondence delivered to the County of Orange at, or prior to, the conclusion of the public review period or the public hearing.

The location of the Planning Commission's and Board of Supervisors' hearings will be at their respective meeting rooms at 10 Civic Center Plaza, 333 West Santa Ana Boulevard, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, Santa Ana, CA 92701.

**COMMENTS:** All comments must be written and should be directed to Tom C. **SIGNIFICANT ENVIRONMENTAL EFFECTS:** Significant environmental effects were identified in the Draft Supplement to Final EIR 564 in the area of Agricultural Lands, both individually and cumulatively.

Final EIR 564 identified potentially significant impacts in the areas of: Land Use and Planning; Water Quality; Transportation and Circulation; Noise; Aesthetics; Hazards; Public Services; and Utilities and Service Systems. However, Final EIR 564 included mitigation measures that reduced all those potentially significant impacts to a less than significant level.

The review period for the Draft Supplement to EIR 564 commences on August 9, 2012 and will close on September 24, 2012 at 4:00 p.m.
