Dana Point Police Services will be implementing the following road closure during the Festival of Whales Parade on Saturday, March 1, 2014.

**Important Road Closure Information that affects your Home or Business!**

The annual Festival of Whales Parade will be held on Pacific Coast Highway again this year. Several changes have been made to minimize the inconvenience to the surrounding area. Your home or business may be impacted by the road closures in place for this event. The parade will start at PCH and Selva at 10:00 am and proceed southbound on PCH to Golden Lantern. The parade will disband on San Juan Avenue. We would like to encourage everyone to come out and watch the parade. The parade can be viewed on either side of PCH between Selva and Golden Lantern.

The following roads will be closed for the parade:

**Saturday March 1, 2014 from 8:00 am until 12:00 pm (4 hours)**

Roads to be closed	From	To
PCH	Golden Lantern	Selva Rd.
San Juan Ave.	Violet Lantern	Golden Lantern

There will be **NO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC** allowed on PCH during the closures, nor will traffic be allowed to cross PCH during the closures.

Del Prado will be open from Blue Lantern to Golden Lantern during the closure period. The open southbound lanes will allow motorists to leave the area. Motorists can re-enter the area by driving through the Harbor and taking Cove Road to Green Lantern, Santa Clara, Blue Lantern and back to Del Prado.

Access to and from the Dana Point Harbor Area will be continuously available through the intersection of PCH and Del Obispo or by using Golden Lantern. Golden Lantern will not be closed during the event. Expect delays if you use Golden Lantern.

Access to Niguel Beach Terrace, Chelsea Pointe, and the commercial building on Selva at PCH may be slightly delayed, but will not be completely closed.

Dana Point Police Services and other City Departments will make every effort to minimize the inconvenience to the residents, businesses, and visitors in the area of the parade.
