- Ryan White Requirements to be Eligible and Qualify
 - This document provides an overview of the Ryan White/HRSA eligibility requirements, the service specific qualifications, an overview of services that require a referral, and a link to the 2014 poverty/Income websites
- Required Eligibility and Program Overview
 - This document provides a listing of acceptable documents required for eligibility screening and an overview of various programs (e.g., ADAP, Ryan White, OA-HIPP)
- Eligibility Verification Information Request
 - This document is used to request information regarding a client's eligibility status
