The COUNTY OF ORANGE, HOUSING & COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT / COMMUNITY INVESTMENT DIVISION - ORANGE COUNTY WORKFORCE INVESTMENT BOARD is seeking proposals from qualified organizations to provide Labor Market Information and Economic Development (LMI/ED) functions and activities for (PY) 2008-2009.

The Orange County Workforce Investment Board (OCWIB) is releasing a Request for Proposals (RFP) for Program Year (PY) 2007-2008 Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Services for Labor Market Information and Economic Development functions and activities.

Entities that may be interested in responding to this (LMI/ED) Request for Proposal are encouraged to respond to this RFP. It is anticipated that approximately \$200,000 will be available for the work outlined in this RFP. Responses to this RFP process will be considered for a funding cycle beginning January 1, 2008 and ending June 30, 2009.

Proposals must be received by OCWIB staff before October 29, 2007 by 4:00 p.m., in order to be considered for funding.
