**Wednesday, April 28-
Thursday, April 29**

The National Weather Service has issued a Hazardous Weather Outlook for Orange County coastal areas, and coastal waters from San Mateo Point to the Mexican border and out 30 NM. A Wind Advisory will be in effect from 8:00am Wednesday, April 28th to 8:00pm Thursday, April 29th.

A large trough of low pressure over the western states will bring strong onshore winds of 15 to 25 mph with gusts up to 40 mph, as well as higher surf and dangerous rip currents for the beaches. The winds will be strongest during the afternoons and early evenings.

Please exercise extreme caution during all boating activities in the coming days and take the time to properly secure your vessel while in its slip.
