New Health Care Agency Director Selected

(Santa Ana, CA) — County Executive Officer Thomas G. Mauk has appointed David L. Riley to serve as Director of the Orange County Health Care Agency (HCA), effective immediately.

HCA's major program areas include Public Health Services, Behavioral Health Services and Medical and Institutional Health Services.

He first joined HCA in 1983 and has held a number of administrative positions with the Agency, including Chief Financial Officer, Chief Compliance Officer and Assistant Agency Director. During his more than 30 years with the County, he has also worked for the County Administrative Office, Probation Department and Human Services Agency.

A graduate of California State University, Fullerton with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Business Administration, Riley also graduated from the Kennedy School of Government Executive Education Program at Harvard University and the Orange County Leadership Academy.
