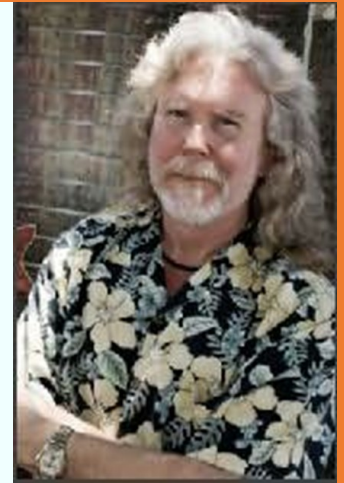
WRITING LITERARY GENRE FICTION

Baron was a professional musician, guitarist, singer and songwriter, and independent record label founder.

Using his experience he plays with music, song lyrics and the use of symbolism, setting and metaphors to create images and mood in his presentations.



Baron's first two hardboiled mystery novels, **Roadhouse Blues** and **Ruby Tuesday** were L.A. Times and IMBA Best-Sellers. **Angels Fall**, the third in the series was nominated for the 2009 Left Coast Crime Award (the "Lefty") for Best Law Enforcement/ Police Procedural novel of the year.

Rain Dogs is his first stand-alone novel, and a Claymore Award finalist. Baron has served as a judge for both the Edgar and the Shamus Awards.
