Give your child opportunities to participate in pre-writing activities. Be sure to praise their attempts and appreciate how their abilities improve over time. Some activities to try include:

- Adding their "writing" to cards, shopping lists, or letters
- Playing with clay
- Lacing cards
- Painting with q-tips
- Drawing with their fingers in corn meal, salt, or sand in a tray
- Using tongs to pick up pompoms or cotton balls
