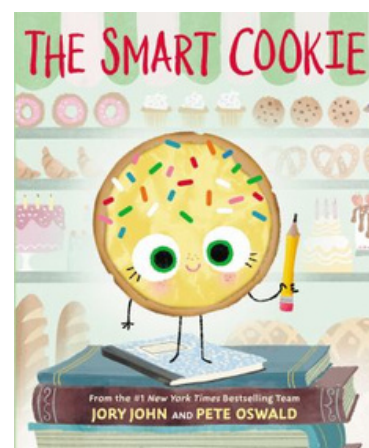


I Wiggle
