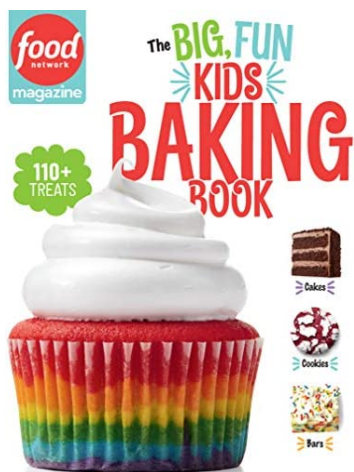

As fast as you can.

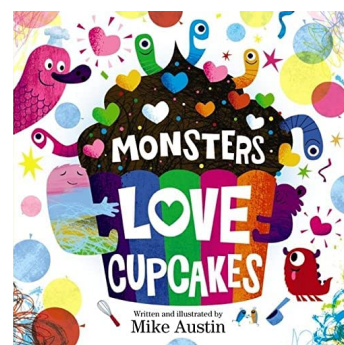
Roll it,
