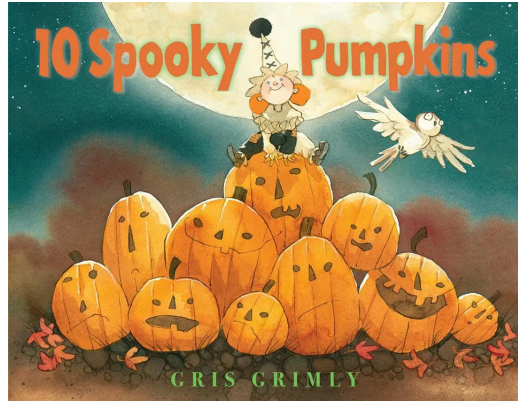


KINDERGARTEN READINESS TIPS
