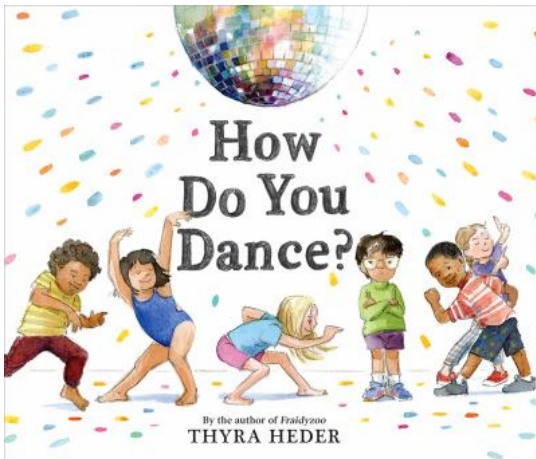


KINDERGARTEN READINESS TIPS

Grown-up Tip

Movement songs are a great way to build gross motor skills. The motions for the songs like “Head, Shoulders, Knees, and Toes” ask kids to cross all three midlines: top to bottom, left to right, and front to back which requires coordination from the right and left sides of the brain. Crossing the midline is even important to reading and writing as the hand and eye must cross a page while words are read or written. So have your kids make those movements while singing!
