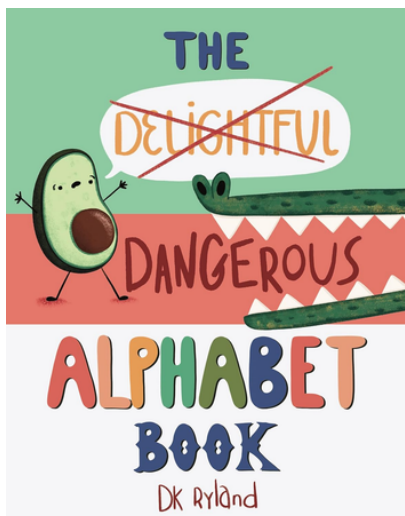

around

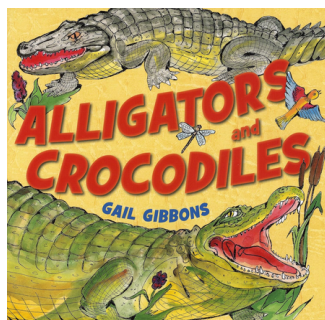
D is for dizzy -
